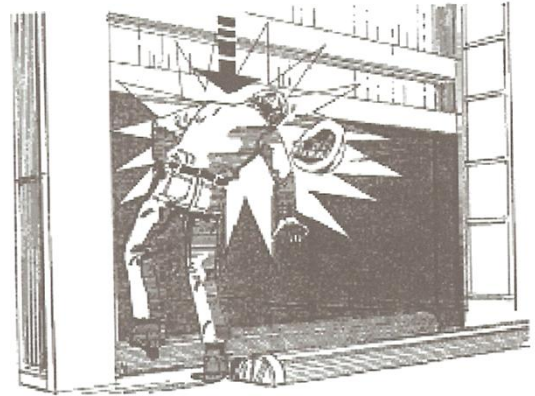
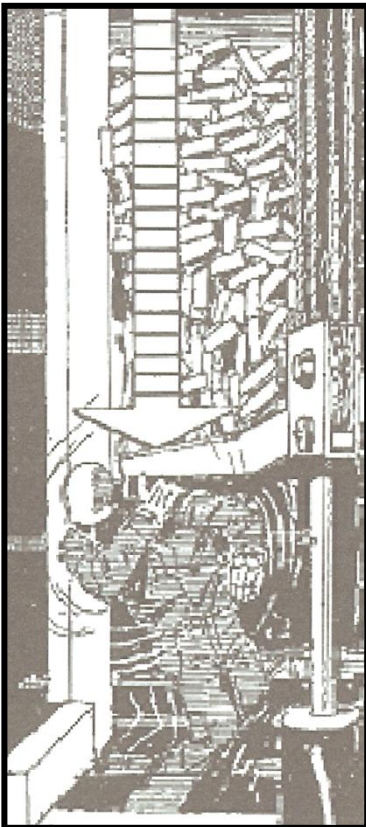


SAFETY ALERT

When Preparing For Lockout Don't Forget To Consider Energy Sources Such As Gravity, Electrical, Or Pressure That Can Be Stored Or Reaccumulate...



Be Sure To Take Steps To Properly Assess All Of The Possible Energy Sources That You May Be Exposed To And The Hazards They Present



Effective energy control procedures prevent the **unexpected** energizing/start up or **release** of energy that could occur and cause injury. **Potential sources of stored energy** can include: pneumatic, hydraulic, mechanical, thermal, electrical, and.... **DON'T FORGET GRAVITY** (when working under hoist systems, lumber sorter bins, etc). When preparing for lockout, stored energy sources should be relieved, restrained, disconnected or otherwise made safe before proceeding with the task. Methods to control energy should include the use of an energy-isolating device/method that physically prevents the transmission or release of energy during completion of the task. Taking these preventive steps can save your life!
